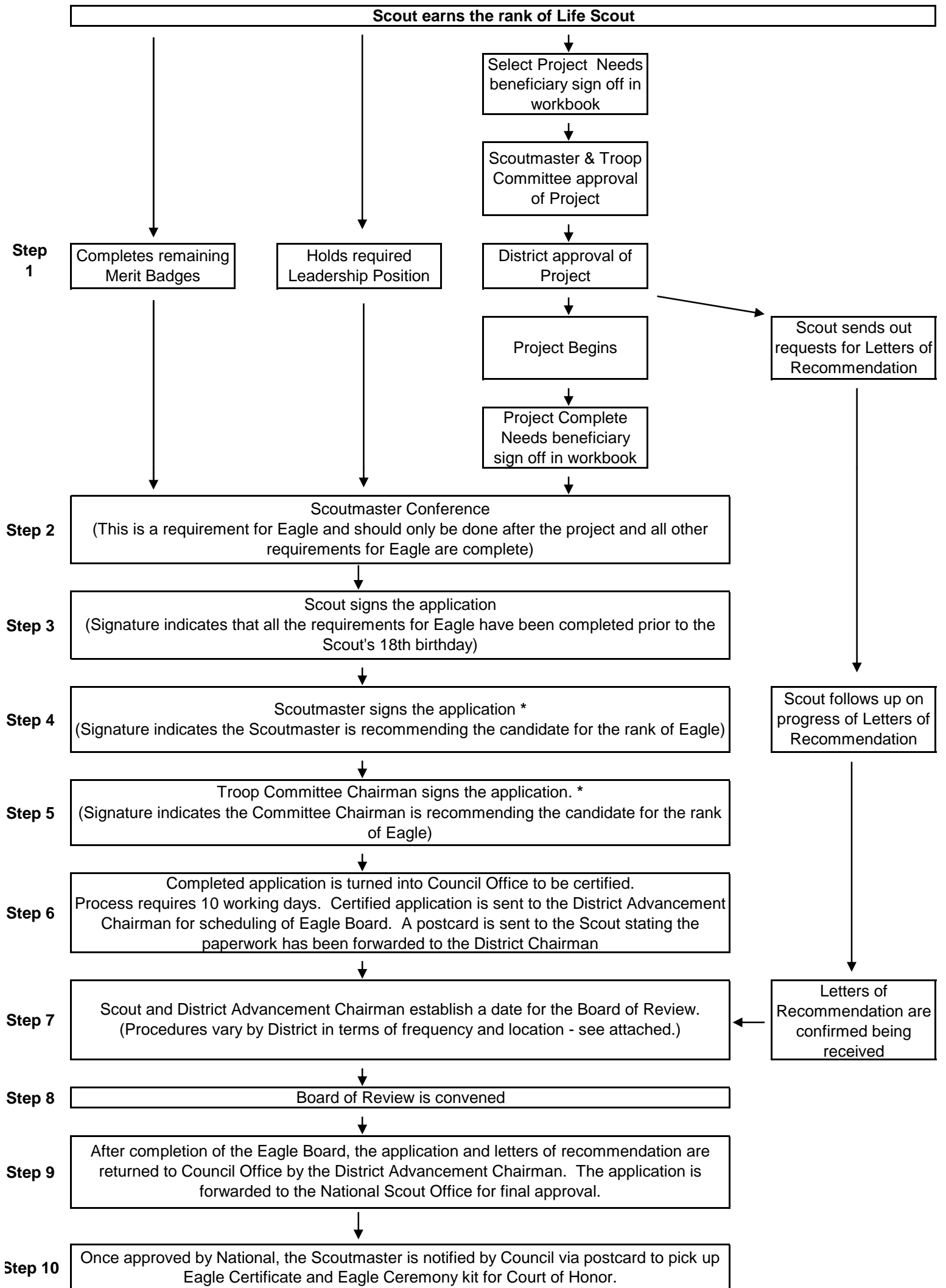


# Life to Eagle 10 Step Process



\* Should the Scoutmaster or Committee Chairman not support the Scout for the rank of Eagle, they must provide a letter to the Scout within ten days of the meeting stating their concerns. The Scout attaches a copy of those letters to the application and may continue to apply for Eagle. In such an event, the application is not signed or dated by the Scoutmaster or Committee Chairman.

# Life to Eagle 10 Step Process

## Individual District Guidelines and procedures for Setting Board of Reviews and Letters of Recommendation

**Potawatomi District:** Letters of Recommendation are held by the Council Office. Once the application is certified by Council it is sent along with the letter of recommendation to the District Advancement Chairman. A postcard is sent to the Scout stating that his application is ready and he should contact the Advancement Chairman to schedule a Board of Review. Boards are generally scheduled at the monthly District Round Table meetings.

**Aptakistic District:** Letters of Recommendation are held by the Advancement Chairman. Once the application is certified by Council a postcard is sent to the Scout and the application is sent to the Advancement Chairman. The Chairman contacts the Scout to schedule an appointment. Board of Reviews are generally held on the second and fourth Saturday of each month.

**North Star District:** Letters of Recommendation are held by the Advancement Chairman. Once the application is certified by Council a postcard is sent to the Scout and the application is sent to the Advancement Chairman. The Chairman contacts the Scout to schedule an appointment. Board of Reviews are scheduled as necessary throughout the month.

### **Other Items:**

It is important to know that the steps to completing the Eagle requirements must be finished in the sequential order laid out above and cannot be moved around. For example, a Scoutmaster conference may not take place prior to the Scout having all the requirements in Step 1 complete.
